The Eating Disorder Recovery Program, of Women's Health Clinic, is seeking a qualified individual to provide part-time (3 days per week) psychological services.

The Eating Disorder Recovery Program is a new multi disciplinary program that coordinates and delivers services to individuals over the age of 16 who are experiencing disordered eating. The Psychologist would provide assessment and counselling services to individuals and families; would create and facilitate groups; would participate in the development, evaluation and research components of the program; and would provide on-site consultation with other team and community members. The team includes a Program Coordinator, Counsellors, Dietitian, Nurse Practitioner and Physician.

**Qualifications:**

**Minimum requirements**

- PhD in Clinical Psychology including a completed internship / residency in Clinical Psychology.
- Registration with the Psychological Association of Manitoba (C. Psych or C. Psych Candidate).
- Knowledge of assessment and treatment of disordered eating, including experience with relevant mental health conditions and psychological processes that influence eating disorders and weight preoccupation.
- Clinical experience with adults and teens experiencing disordered eating.
- Understanding of and commitment to Women's Health Clinic's model of Care and feminist counseling principles.
- Experience in group facilitation.
- Excellent interpersonal and written communication skills including basic competency in word processing and email.
- Demonstrated initiative and problem solving skills.
- Demonstrated ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds.
- Demonstrate knowledge and awareness of women's health issues.
- Pro-choice feminist perspective.
- Professional liability insurance.
